Meetings held under UKA Rules. Pacemakers are not allowed in any Open races, either for the race as a whole or for specific athletes within a race unless arranged with the organisers.

1200 U15 High Jump followed by U13
1200 U11 Long Jump followed by U13 then U15
1200 U15 & U13 Discus (29th Mar, 8th May, 31st Aug) or Hammer (13th Apr, 25th May) followed by U15 & U13 Javelin followed by U15 & U13 Shot

1. Athletes must compete in their own age group.
2. Four attempts only for U15 field events, three attempts for U13 & U11 field events.
3. You may return to a field event if you have to leave for another event as long as the field event has not finished. Athletes returning to the HJ will continue at the bar's current height.
4. U15 & U13 can do a maximum of three events.
5. U11s can do a maximum of 2 track and 1 field event. Minimum age nine.
6. U13s & U15s may not do both 800m & 1200m/1500m.
7. Starting blocks are not provided.
8. Entry on the day £6 (£2 for each extra event) Spectators £2.
9. Medals to the first three in all events in each age group.
10. Requests for performances not to be submitted to Power of Ten will be denied.
11. The organisers reserve the right to change any detail within the programme.
12. If electronic timing is unavailable, hand timings will be used.
13. External photographic/video evidence cannot be used to determine a result.
