

Trafford Combined Events Classic Information 2025

Thank you for entering the Trafford Combined Events Classic on Saturday 13th and Sunday 14th September. On Saturday the U13 Girls, U15 Boys, U17, U20 and Senior athletes are in action. The U13 Boys and U15 Girls have their competitions on Sunday along with the second day of competition for the U17, U20 and Senior athletes.

Please find attached the provisional timetable for both days. This is a guide to the start times and is subject to change throughout the day. Please note that the starting times are when the event is scheduled to begin so warm ups should be completed before then. Please listen carefully for announcements throughout the day. If events finish earlier or take longer than planned we will announce a revised start time for the next event.

The Meeting will start at 9:30 on both days and is expected to finish by 4:45.

Electronic timing will be in use for all races.

If you are unable to take part for any reason please can you email the office as soon as possible on open@traffordac.co.uk as we may be able to fill these spaces.

Start lists will be published and emailed out on Friday once the fields have been finalised.

General Competition Rules

Athletes will have 3 attempts in the Long Jump, Shot Putt, Javelin and Discus.

In the High Jump the bar will be increased in 3cm increments. In the Pole Vault the bar will go up in 10cm increments. Starting heights for each competition will be negotiated before the start of each competition.

U13G and U15G will be divided into 2 pools for their field events. For ease of the competition, the pools will be based on known High Jump PBs and the pools will remain the same for the Shot Putt and Long Jump competitions and will be detailed when you receive the startlist later in the week.

Please note that as is common with any Combined Event competition if an athlete fails to attempt to start or make a trial in one of the events the athlete shall not be allowed to take part in the subsequent events but shall be considered to have abandoned the competition. The athlete shall, therefore, not figure in the final classification. Any athlete deciding to withdraw from the competition should inform the Combined Events Referee of their decision.

Presentations for each age group will take place as soon as possible following the completion of the last event.

Officials/Volunteers

We have our key officials in place but still need some more helpers/volunteers to help out on the field or on the track. This will greatly help with the smooth running and timings of the events.
